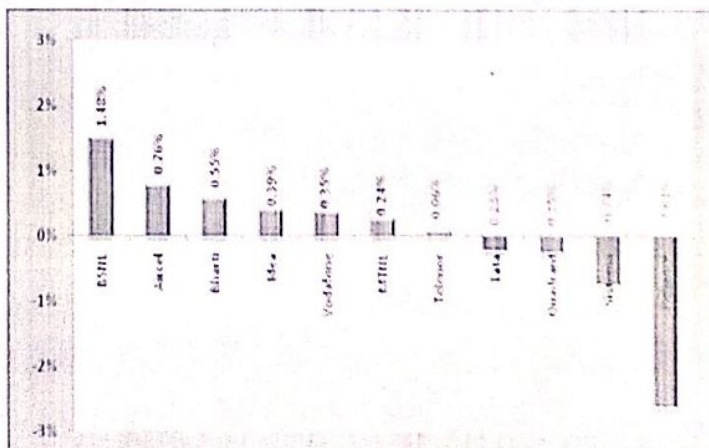
BSNL became the fifth largest mobile operator, beats all major private operators in monthly growth rate and in net addition of new customers in June-2016 -TRAI.
