req.**


As regards the agitational programme conducted by some associations of the Executives, we have come to know that severe victimisations are being imposed on the leaders of those associations. It is understood that, while wage cut is being imposed for conducting demonstrations / dharna, action has also been initiated for imposing punishment on the leaders of those associations.

In this connection, we wish to point out that, the imposition of wage cut, for demonstrations and dharna is not acceptable, and it tantamounts to denial of the right to assembly, which is enshrined in the Constitution of the country. At a time when all the unions and associations in BSNL are working shoulder to shoulder with the Management, for improving the quality of services and to improve the revenue of the Company, imposition of severe victimisations for trade union actions are uncalled for.


