Respected Sir,


You will please recall the unions as well as employees came forward to contribute from their salary creation of "Benevolent Fund" so that a cheque of Rs.10 lakhs may be given for the families of Covid-19 deceased employees. It will be appreciated this is meager amount of help and distressed families cannot survive for long from this amount and permanent assistance is needed. It will not be out of context to state that many organizations including State Govts have extended many concessions including employment to wards.

Some years past discussions took place in National Council and decision was arrived at that in the event of death of employees on duty the wards will be offered Job on priority basis. In this connection reference is invited to BSNL HQR letter No.-273-18/2013/CGA/Estt-IV. The deaths due pandemic have placed the deceased families in enormous miserable condition. We have no hesitation in stating that the financial crunch of the PSU should not stand in the way of employment of wards and the denial will not augur well also some young employees of BSNL status have died and their families will not get even pensionary benefits. Such families will undergo immeasurable hardships.

We, therefore, entreat upon you for consideration of the mater in all perspectives and offer job to the dependents of Covid -19 deceased employees including such also who died while on duty. Steps be taken, if need be, to get necessary relaxation from appropriate level.
