Kindly recall our discussion of 03-06-2016 regarding revengeful and vindictive action of the officer noted above. Sequel to his transfer the officer has become more and more vindictive and has issued back date orders of transfers as well as chargesheets against the union functionaries you had been kind enough to assure that all these will be withdrawn but the relief of the officer is being avoided due to obvious reasons. The union has already submitted details vide letter No.-TF-36/2, dt-03-06-2016 (copy enclosed).

We are deeply appalled and hurt to note that Shri K.K. Singh, Assistant office Supdt. Who is Secretary of NFTE (CHQ) has been transferred to a place just to demoralize the employees and to create terror amongst the staff.

We may also state that the aforesaid officer has worked as DE, Dy. GM earlier at the place at different intervals and trying to settle scores with the workers. It will not be out of context to state that he was also in the "Agreed List" of CBI while serving as Dy. GMT at Jamshedpur and now trying to become CGM at Jharkhand circle. He has indulged in questionable and unthinkable approach as he is habitual to use abusive words against staff including ladies. The SSA Head has withheld payment of salary in respect of officials, S/S Kishore Kumar Singh, Ajay Kumar Tewari and Ashok Kumar vide Letter No.-E-186-Estt Genl/64, dt-08-07-2016 (copy enclosed).

We, therefore, appeal to you to please intervene and get the orders of transfers and chargesheets etc withdrawn in the interest of harmonious relation.
