**Subject:-** Implementation of revival plan vis-à-vis neglect of leased circuits, FTTH, Broad Band etc services – reg.

Respected Sir,

We have occasions to state that the much talked revival plan has been executed without drawing the roadmap for the purpose. This has started affecting the services specially lease circuits, Broadband FTTH, etc due to non-maintenance. We are reasonably worried and concerned although the unions have not been taken into confidence at any stage or level in the VRS matter. If the present situation is allowed to continue the expected migration of customers due to recent Supreme Court Judgement on "AGR" may not come to our company.


It is pertinent to mention that in the HOCC meeting, held on 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>, February, 2020 even the Secretary (T) has said as below

".....Leased circuits of the bank remained faulty for long time. Many banks have complained to DOT also" This vindicates the unions statement.

We, therefore request you to please consider the issue in real perspective so that the vital services are taken due care to generate revenue. The union is deeply interested to ensure that the BSNL sails and it should not even swim.
